INVOCATION

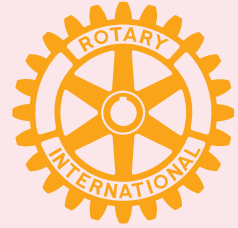

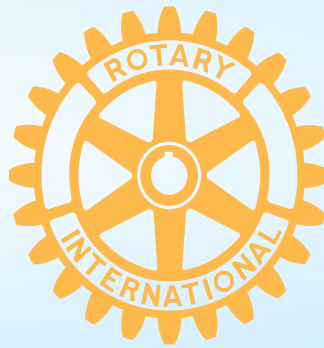
