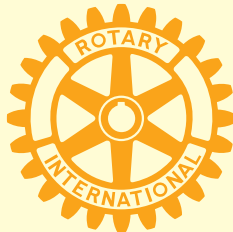

## INVOCATION

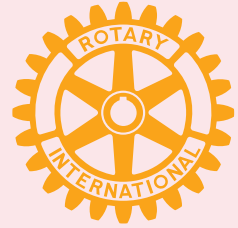
